3. Supplemental Information

3.1. Bid Price Form Excel File has been provided for Contractor's use.

4. Responses to Bidder Questions

4.1. Would it be possible to push the bid date to the following week on the 17th of March. The largest construction exposition in the world which is held every 3 years is from March 3-7 and is a great opportunity to get hands on experience with the latest technology coming out in our field.

Response: The bid opening date will not be delayed and will remain 2:00pm, local time, March 10, 2026. Refer to page INV - 1 of 4 within the Invitation to Bid.

4.2. For the testing and inspection scope, will these services be contracted directly by the Owner or by the Contractor?

Response: The Contractor is required to provide an independent, certified testing laboratory for all tests required per the project specifications to serve as Quality Control. Refer to Section 1400 "Quality Control Services". The DOA with assistance from the firm conducting Construction Services will provide a Quality Assurance testing laboratory to backcheck the Contractor's Quality Control tests.

4.3. If the services are to be contracted by the Owner, will they be assigned under an existing on-call contract, or will they be procured through a separate competitive bid process?

Response: See 4.2 for additional information.

4.4. Will you accept a Florida Underground Utility & Excavation and/or FDOT Prequalification in lieu of a General Contractor's License?

Response: The solicitation specifies that a General Contractor license is required for this project's Prime Contractor. It is the responsibility of the prime contractor to ensure compliance with all applicable licensing laws and regulations, including those outlined in Chapter 489 of the Florida Statutes and any relevant Palm Beach County Code provisions. The prime contractor must independently verify that their license meets all statutory and contractual requirements for the scope of work described in this solicitation. If, upon award, it is determined that a different license classification is necessary, the Contractor will be required to obtain the appropriate license without delay and without impact to the project schedule. Florida Underground Utility & Excavation License and/or FDOT Prequalification is acceptable for a subcontractor.

- 4.5. Base Bid: When comparing the limits of mill and the existing edge of pavement it appears there is some widening and some removal of existing asphalt on the south side of perimeter road. Can these limits be shown on the plans?**

Response: The intent of the milling and resurfacing limits shown on Perimeter Road is to match the existing edges of pavement unless otherwise shown as new construction, reconstruction, or widening.

- 4.6. Base Bid: Bid Items 22 and 67. Why are there two sod bid items?**

Response: The two sod bid items are related to two different uses. Bid Item 22 "Performance Turf, Sod" pertains to restoration or harmonization of staging area. Bid Item 67 "Sod - St. Augustine" refers to the sodding shown on the plan sheets.

- 4.7. Base Bid: Bid Items 12 and 61. Why are there two clearing and grubbing bid items?**

Response: Bid Item Description "General Site Work/Demolition/Root Pruning/Clearing and Grubbing" has been updated to "General Landscaping Site Work/Demolition/Root Pruning" for clarity.

- 4.8. Can a bid item be added for the irrigation?**

Response: Irrigation pay item has been added to bid form.

- 4.9. The landscape plans appear to show root barrier. Can a bid item be added for root barrier?**

Response: Root Barrier pay item has been added to bid form.

- 4.10. Plan Sheet C-09.05, Irrigation Restoration Notes: Can an asbuilt bid item for the irrigation asbuilts as this isn't a standard asbuilt and needs to be done by the irrigation subcontractor?**

Response: No new pay item will be required. As-built information for irrigation work shall be included with the other project close out documents.

4.11. Plan Sheet C-10.01. There appear to be 14 new slash pines. Can a bid item be added for the slash pines?

Response: Slash Pines pay item has been added to bid form.

4.12. Plan Sheet C-11.01. Please confirm the "gravel check dam" spaced every 50'. This is usually only done in mountainous areas. Also, can a detail be provided?

Response: The "gravel check dams" are spaced every 50ft. Based on recent history at the Airport, soil conditions required gravel check dams. If Contractor elects to approach the SWPPP differently, it is the Contractor's responsibility to employ best management practices throughout construction in order to ensure pollution prevention. Contractor shall comply with all local state and other governmental environmental regulations throughout construction.

4.13. Plan Sheet C-11.02. Please confirm the "temp rock bags" between stations 14+00 and 16+00, RT are required. Typically inlet protection would be fine. If the rock bags are required will the sod that needs to be replaced upon removal be paid for in one of the two sod bid items?

Response: The "temp rock bags" shown are one option for inlet protection. If Contractor elects to approach the SWPPP differently, it is the Contractor's responsibility to employ best management practices throughout construction in order to ensure pollution prevention. Contractor shall comply with all local state and other governmental environmental regulations throughout construction.

4.14. Plan Sheet S-00.02, note 1.8. Can you verify if this note applies to the cantilever sign?

Response: Yes, this note applies to the proposed cantilever sign. In addition, Contractor shall install signage per the FDOT Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction.

4.15. Can local shellrock from an FDOT approved rock pit be used for the baserock?

Response: Per FDOT Flexible Pavement Design Manual, Shell Rock, LBR 100 is an acceptable option as long as it is acquired from an FDOT approved rock pit.

4.16. Can the floritam sod quantity be verified? I am coming up with approximately 2/3 of the actual total from the landscape plans.

Response: Sod limits have been updated on Sheet C-10.01 and C-10.02, see Section 2 above for additional information.

4.17. The proposed location of the relocated palm trees are shown on the landscaping plans, but the identification of which trees are to be moved there aren't. Can the trees be identified so we can visit the site to assess how much it will cost to move them?

Response: There are two palm trees scheduled for relocation. Palm Tree #48 (Cabbage Palm) and Palm Tree #119 (Cabbage Palm) See Tree Disposition chart on sheet C-08.05.

4.18. There are 19 proposed live oaks shown on the landscaping plans. The bid schedule states 11. Which is correct?

Response: See Section 2 above for clarification.

4.19. Plan Sheet C-2.02A. There is a note that says "See Note 5" pointing to the asphalt where the guardrail is supposed to be installed. There is no Note 5 on this sheet. Please advise.

Response: Note 5 has been added to Sheet C-02.02A, see Section 2 above for additional information.

4.20. Bid Alternate 13 Base Group 09. Can the quantity be reviewed? I'm coming up with approximately 1/2 of the bid schedule quantities vs what is shown on the plans.

Response: See Section 2 above for clarification.

- 4.21. Bid Alternate: When comparing the survey to the geometry plan sheet it appears that a good portion of perimeter road will need to be sawcut on the edges and small portion will need to be removed prior to paving. Is that the intent? There is no sod shown here.**

Response: No, the intent is to mill and resurface the existing asphalt roadway as shown on "Typical Section 1: Perimeter Road" on Sheet C-05.01A. Refer to "Typical Section 2: Perimeter Road" on Sheet C-05.01A for portions shown as construction, reconstruction, and/or widening.

- 4.22. The insurance limits set forth in the ITB require \$10,000,000 in General Liability (\$5,000,000 per occurrence and \$10,000,000 aggregate) and \$5,000,000 in Automobile Liability. Given the nature and scope of the project, these limits appear high. Will the Airport consider revising the insurance requirements to industry-standard limits, including \$3,000,000 General Liability (\$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$3,000,000 aggregate) and \$1,000,000 Automobile Liability, or similar coverage?**

Response: No, the bidders shall meet the insurance requirements shown within the Contract Documents.

- 4.23. Is there an Owner's/Engineer's Estimate established for the Base Bid and the Bid Alternate, and if so, can the estimated amount be provide for each?**

Response: There is an Owner's/Engineer's Estimate for the project but that information will not be available to Contractors.

- 4.24. Please confirm whether lane closures are permitted on Turnage Boulevard and the Perimeter Road during phase transitions and final paving operations, and if permitted, provide the allowable days, hours, maximum number of lanes allowed to be closed, and any sequencing restrictions.**

Response: Turnage Blvd's only lane closure required/allowed will be the merge lane. The three existing lanes on Turnage Blvd. shall remain open for the duration of the Base Bid. If a temporary lane closure is required for the removal and replacement of the cantilever sign, Contractor shall coordinate with the DOA and RPR a minimum of 48 hours prior

to beginning work.

Phase transitions and final paving operations were considered within the phase durations contained in the Contract Documents.

- 4.25. Please confirm whether a curb pad is required for F-Type curb installation, and if required, provide composition or spec reference.**

Response: No curb pad is required. Curb base shall be constructed per Typical Section 2: Ramp A on Sheet C-05.01.

- 4.26. The bid form includes separate pay items for Performance Turf and St. Augustine Grass; please confirm how the Lump Sum quantity for Performance Turf is to be determined by the Owner.**

Response: See Response under Question 4.6 for clarification.

- 4.27. Plan Sheets G-01.01 and C-10.01 show differing sod limits; please confirm which plan sheet governs. Can the areas designated for St. Augustine Grass versus Performance Turf be called out on the plans as well?**

Response: Sod limits have been updated on Sheet C-10.01 and C-10.02, see Section 2 above for additional information.

- 4.28. Per the phasing plans, Phases 1C and 2 require the use of free-standing barrier wall. FDOT Standard 102-100 provides required installation offsets and barrier wall width requirements. Field measurements indicate the existing roadway width between vegetation edges along the Perimeter Road varies from approximately 15 to 17 feet. Please confirm that sufficient width exists to install the required free-standing barrier wall in accordance with FDOT Standard 102-100 in both phases.**

Response: Existing roadway width can be reduced to allow for standing barrier wall installation per FDOT Standard 102-100. The contractor shall maintain a minimum of 11ft wide lanes.

- 4.29. On Bid Alternate Plan Sheet C-02.01A, the Northern run of guardrail in the westbound lane side appears to conflict with a depicted electrical line crossing the proposed guardrail alignment at approximately Station 27+25. Please confirm whether the Engineer has verified that no conflict exists at this location, and if a conflict does exist, confirm whether special posts or modified installation requirements will be necessary.**

Response: Utilities shown on plans are based on the best available information at the time of design. Per contract documents the Contractor is responsible for verification of all utilities prior to beginning any construction operations.

- 4.30. In the Base Bid phasing, Phases 1A and 1B include milling, resurfacing, and temporary construction to shift traffic. Please confirm whether these phases are intended to be milled and resurfaced in a single 2-inch lift. If so, please confirm that barrier wall for Phase 1C is intended to be placed on the final surface. If the lifts are intended to be split to accommodate Phase 1C, please provide the MOT phasing for the placement of the final lift while maintaining traffic access.**

Response: Confirmed. The intent is to perform the milling and resurfacing within a single 2-inch lift. Additionally, the intention is to place the barrier walls on the finished surface during Phase 1C.

- 4.31. Per the Typical Section, an Asphalt Transition detail is shown requiring milling 5 feet beyond the limits of widening into the existing pavement, with a thickness consistent with the proposed 3-inch asphalt section. Please confirm under which bid item this transition milling work is to be included. Is the asphalt for this area also assumed in the appropriate bid items?**

Response: Additional quantities associated with the Asphalt Transition are accounted for within the existing pay items (i.e. milling and superpave asphalt).

¹ The percentage committed to on this form must be supported by the dollar amounts listed on Schedules 1 and 2. Errors in calculating the DBE percentage may result in a correction of the DBE percentage pursuant to Section 11.4 of the Instructions to Bidders. In the event the DBE goal is not achieved, failure to submit evidence of good faith efforts shall cause the bid submitted by the Bidder to be nonresponsive to the Invitation to Bid.

THE REMAINDER OF THIS FORM MUST BE COMPLETED IF A DBE GOAL HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED FOR THIS SOLICITATION AND THE BIDDER HAS BEEN UNABLE TO ACHIEVE THE DBE GOAL.

In the event Bidder is unable to achieve an established DBE goal, the Bidder is required to demonstrate that the Bidder took all necessary and reasonable steps to secure participation by certified DBE firms by their scope, intensity and appropriateness to the objective. Mere pro forma efforts such as blanket mailings or e-mails requesting quotes without further efforts will not be considered a good faith effort. The quality, quantity and intensity of the Bidder's efforts will be considered in determining good faith efforts. Actions constituting evidence of good faith efforts are described in Appendix A to 49 CFR Part 26. Such actions include, but are not limited to, the actions identified in this form. Schedule 3 is not intended to be an exhaustive list of the actions that may be taken in an effort to achieve the DBE goal.

In the event a DBE goal has been established for this solicitation, failure to complete Schedule 3 in its entirety and submit information as required by this Schedule 3 shall cause the bid submitted by the Bidder to be nonresponsive to the DBE requirements when the DBE goal has not been achieved; however, completion of the form alone will not necessarily result in a finding of good faith efforts. The purpose of Schedule 3 is to provide detailed information to the County regarding the scope, intensity and appropriateness of the steps taken by each Bidder to achieve the DBE goal. Determinations of good faith efforts are intrinsically fact-specific and are made taking into consideration the evidence provided by each Bidder as to its efforts. Failure to provide sufficient evidence of good faith efforts shall cause the bid submitted by the Bidder to be nonresponsive to the DBE requirements when the DBE goal has not been

achieved.

1. **CONTACT LOG.** The Bidder shall provide a contact log with Schedule 3 that contains the following information: (1) the name of each DBE firm contacted, (2) the initial date each DBE firm was solicited, (3) how each DBE firm was solicited (i.e., correspondence, e-mail, fax, telephone, etc...), (4) dates of follow up efforts; (5) a summary of the follow up efforts (i.e., correspondence, e-mail, fax, telephone conversations, meetings, etc...), and (6) the general results of Bidder's efforts. The efforts employed by the Bidder must be those that one could reasonably expect the Bidder to take if the Bidder were actively and aggressively trying to obtain DBE participation to meet the goal. Direct communication is the most effective means of securing DBE participation. The Bidder may use the contact log form attached to Schedule 3 or may provide a separate contact log with the information required by this paragraph. Failure to provide the required contact log or submission of a materially incomplete contact log shall cause the bid submitted by the Bidder to be nonresponsive to the DBE requirements. The contact log is utilized to assist the County in determining the quality, quantity and intensity of the efforts made by each of Bidder to achieve the DBE goal.
 - A. The Bidder should provide backup documentation supporting the statements contained in the contact log, including copies of solicitation letters, e-mails, faxes, and telephone logs, with Schedule 3; however, supporting documentation shall not be accepted in lieu of a contact log. The County may request copies of supporting documentation listed in the contact log to clarify information included in the contact log if not included or incomplete. It shall be the responsibility of the Bidder to submit the requested information within the timeframe specified by the County (normally within two (2) business days). Failure of the Bidder to provide the requested information within the timeframe specified by the County shall cause the bid submitted by the Bidder to be nonresponsive to the DBE requirements.
 - B. The number and location of DBE firms contacted by the Bidder will be considered in determining good faith efforts. Contacting available DBE firms that specialize in the work desired and that are located in the area or surrounding areas of the Project will be considered further evidence in support of a finding of good faith efforts. Focusing efforts exclusively or primarily outside the area or surrounding areas of the Project without a reasonable explanation raises the question of whether the Bidder made good faith efforts.
 - C. The timing of solicitation of DBE firms by the Bidder will be considered in determining good faith efforts. Soliciting DBE firms as early in the process as practicable to allow DBE firms a sufficient time to respond to the solicitation and submit a timely quote will be considered further evidence in support of a finding of good faith efforts. Failing to provide sufficient time for DBE firms to respond to the Bidder's solicitation raises the question of whether the Bidder made good faith efforts.
 - D. Follow up efforts will be considered in determining good faith efforts as such efforts are relevant to the quality and intensity of the efforts made by the Bidder. The contact log must detail the efforts the Bidder took to follow up with DBE firms following initial solicitation efforts. Follow up efforts should be tracked and documented, including the name of individuals contacted with each DBE firm and the relevant contact information. Blanket e-mails or mailings to DBE firms requesting quotes alone are not sufficient to satisfy good faith efforts. Failing to make reasonable follow up efforts raises the question of whether the Bidder made good faith efforts.
 - E. DBE firms listed in the contact log may be contacted by the County to verify information contained in the contact log. Failure to provide information that is accurate in all material

respects shall cause the bid submitted by the Bidder to be nonresponsive to the DBE requirements.

2. **ADVERTISING.** The Bidder shall list all advertisements soliciting DBE participation on the Project below. Proof of publication or copies of advertisements must be provided with Schedule 3 in order to be considered as evidence of Bidder's good faith efforts. Advertising in minority/women publications and through minority/women organizations and business assistance offices in addition to traditional newspaper advertising may increase the likelihood the DBE goal will be achieved and is strongly encouraged. Advertising alone is not sufficient to satisfy good faith efforts; however, advertising in conjunction with other efforts will be considered further evidence in support of a finding of good faith efforts; provided that such efforts are targeted to increasing participation by DBE firms in the Project.

3. **SUBCONTRACTING CATEGORIES.** Selecting portions of the work to be performed by DBE firms can increase the likelihood that the DBE goal will be achieved. The Bidder shall provide a statement explaining why the quotes submitted by DBE firms were not accepted. The Bidder's failure to negotiate in good faith with interested DBE firms qualified to perform the work shall cause the bid submitted by the Bidder to be nonresponsive to the DBE requirements.

In addition, the fact that there may be additional costs involved in finding and using DBE firms is not a sufficient reason for the Bidder's failure to meet the DBE goal. Rejecting a DBE firm because the quotation for the work was not the lowest received shall not be considered a good faith effort; however, Bidder is not required to accept a higher quote if the difference is excessive or unreasonable.

Prior to determining that a DBE firm's quote is excessive or unreasonable, the Bidder should make reasonable efforts to inquire as to the reasons for the difference between the DBE and non-DBE quotes. 
